The pedagogical approach will allow time for interaction between the attending group and the speakers on both academic and social dimensions. The ESSCSD is held in Adamas in the beautiful island of Milos in Greece.

EDITION 2005 TOPIC

ACQUIRED NEUROLOGICAL COMMUNICATION DISORDERS

All courses of the 2005 topic of the ESSCSD are on the topic of Acquired neurological communication disorders. Four 2 1/2 days courses are offered:

- Communicative disorders following a right hemisphere lesion – Description, evaluation and intervention (Y. Joannette, Montreal, Canada)
- Cognitive underpinnings of language and aphasia and its assessment (M. R. McNeil, Pittsburgh, USA)
- Aphasia and its recovery: Integrating clinical and neurobiological evidence (A. I. Ansaldo, Montreal, Canada)
- Language therapy and cognitive models (I. Papathanasiou, Patras, Greece)
